- 1876 Cynllun Prosiect Cadnant.**
1876. Cafwyd adroddiad llawn gan y Clerc ei fod wedi bod mewn cysylltiad gyda'r Cadeirydd ar Is-Gadeirydd am syniadau gwella tirwedd y pentref yn Llandegfan, yn enwedig yn sgil lansiad Cynllun Grant Cyfalaf Lleoedd Leol ar gyfer natur drwy Gronfa Dreftadaeth y Loteri Genedlaethol ac roedd wedi anfon llythyr i'r Cyngor Sir yn gofyn am eu sylwadau i'r syniad o ddatblygu darn o dir ar hyd Lon Ganol a gwella y safle y wal gyferbyn a Siop Llandeg hyd at cysgodfan mynedfa Stad Brynteg. Roedd y Clerc wedi dosbarthu copi o'r ddogfen yn cynnwys y syniadau dan sylw yn ogystal a ymateb y Cyngor Sir. Yn amlwg y bydd rhaid creu y cynllun, derbyn caniatad y tirfeddianwyr a derbyn amcancyfrifon ond dywedodd y Clerc fod amser yn brin ac ei fod angen cymeradwyaeth y Cyngor mewn egwyddor i symud ymlaen gyda'r cynllun a'r cais cymorthdal. **Cymeradwyodd aelodau'r Cyngor y syniad a'r cynig yn unfrydol a byddai'r Clerc yn adrodd yn nol gyda diweddariad yn y cyfarfod nesaf (AR/JK).**

- 1879.1 Diolchodd Cyngorwr Sirol, Alun Roberts, i Llinos Medi, Arweinydd y Cyngor Sir am ei gwaith caled a cyfarfodydd ar y cyd a chafwyd gyda Llywodraeth Cymru a Cyngorau Sirol eraill yn y Gogledd er mwyn mynd ar afael gyda holl materion a godwyd o ddiwrnod I ddiwrnod ar adegau prysur y cyfnod coronafeirws. Roedd yn ymfalchion mai Cyngor Sir Ynys Mon oedd yr unig awdurdod lleol cwbl weithredol pan ddaeth yr amser casglu bocsys ailgylchu drwy gydol y pandemig. Diolchodd yn briodol i holl athrawon Ysgolion yr Ynys a Gweithwyr Allweddol am eu holl waith caled yn ystod y cyfnod digyffelyb hwn ac i Clerc y Cyngor Cymuned y Cyngor yma am rhannu newyddion diweddaraf i'r holl aelodau am y sefyllfa fel y digwyddodd. - 1882.1 Yn dilyn cytundeb cyfarfod Mis Mawrth 2020 a sylwadau cofnod 1881.1, bydd rhaid atal unrhyw plannu coeden/coed a cynnwys plant y pentref yn y gweithgaredd hyd y bydd y sefyllfa yn ddiogel ac yn caniatau.

- 1883 Ail Agor Caeau Chwarae.**
Dyweddodd y Clerc nad oedd y Senedd wedi codi cyfyngiadau ail-agor caeau chwarae ac y bydd rhaid disgwyl am arweiniad a datganiad disgwyliadwy Dydd Gwener 10/7/2020 cyn cymeryd y camau nesaf. Yn y cyfamser roedd am cysylltu gyda Ms Bethan Hywel Jones or Cyngor Sir er mwyn derbyn unrhyw canllawiau a Cwmni Yswiriant Zurich er mwyn derbyn sefyllfa atebolrwydd cyhoeddus.
- 1884 Lon Fain**
Nodwyd fod y goleuadau yn gweithio ond fod gwydr lamp 8 & 9 angen sylw – **Clerc i gysylltu gyda'r Adran Llwybrau.**
- 1885 Cadeiriau Newydd i'r Neuadd.**
Dyweddodd y Clerc nad oedd wedi taro sylw i'r fater yma am y tro oherwydd y sefyllfa coronfeirws ac am nad oedd y Neuadd ar agor. Ond dywedodd fod yr Ysgol wedi dangos diddordeb mewn cymeryd 50 o'r hen cadeiriau.
- 1886 Safle Hysbysfwrdd.**
Yn dilyn sylwadau cofnod 1876, dywedodd y Clerc y bwriedir lleoli yr hysbysfwrdd ger cysgodfan gyferbyn mynedfa Stad Brynteg petai y cynllun arfaethedig yn llwyddiannus.
- 1887 Seddi Newydd Cysgodfan Bysiau.**
Dyweddodd y Clerc nad oedd ganddo datblygiad i'r ymholiadau ac felly roedd rhaid ystyried cysylltu gyda Contractwyr arall am ddyfnbris er mwyn adrodd yn nol i'r cyfarfod nesaf.
- 1888 Kiosk BT Llansadwrn.**
Dyweddodd y Clerc fod y Kiosk bellach mewn eiddo'r Cyngor Cymuned ac fe fydd rhaid symud ymlaen gyda gosod diffibriliwr newydd tu mewn i'r kiosk yn unol a'r cytundeb. Cyn symud ymlaen, atgoffodd y Clerc fod Cyngorydd Sirol Carwyn Jones wedi dweud y bydd Cwmni Alun Griffiths yn fodlon cyfrannu Diffibriliwr newydd i'r pentre fel rhan o'r gwaith cynllun lliniaru llifogydd ond fydd rhaid cadarnhau y sefyllfa ac adrodd yn nol i'r cyfarfod nesaf.

- 1889 Cynllun Gosod Diffibriliwr Ychwanegol.**
Yn dilyn ymholiadau a trafodaeth gyda ‘Welsh Hearts’, cadarnhaodd y Clerc fod ganddo newyddion da ac bod y mudiad wedi llwyddo mewn cymorthdal o osod ddiffibriliwr newydd i’r pentre. Trafodwyd safle addas ar gyfer lleoli y peiriant ac ystyried gaffael a prynu 4 arall - Cyfanswm gwariant tua £5k. **Cytunwyd yr aelodau mewn egwyddor a disgwyl adroddiad pellach yn y cyfarfod nesaf.**
- 1890 Prosiect Peiriant Bag Cŵn.**
Roedd y Clerc wedi bod yn darllen amryw sylwadau ar lwyfannau cyfryngau cymdeithasol lleol yn cwyno am y sefyllfa baw ci yn y pentref ac yn dilyn sylwadau y cyfarfod blaenorol, roedd wedi gwneud ymholiadau ynghylch a gosod peiriannau bagiau cŵn o amgylch y pentref. Dywedodd mai y Cyngor Cymuned a tîm AHNE sy'n gyfrifol o ddewis lleoliad y peiriant. Bydd angen polyn presennol ar y safle a dylai fod yn agos at bin y Cyngor Sir. Y tîm AHNE fydd wedyn yn gosod y peiriannau cyflenwi. Yn olaf, dywedodd fod pob un o’r peiriant yn costio £12.50 ac y bydd y Cyngor Sir yn darparu bagiau o’r stoc sy’n weddill. Ar ôl hynny, cyfrifoldeb y Cyngor Cymuned fydd talu i gadw lefelau stoc a llenwi’r peiriannau. **Cytunwyd yr aelodau symud ymlaen gyda’r prosiect ar frys a gofyn i’r Clerc wneud y trefniadau perthnasol.**
- 1891 Glanhau y Gofeb & Dathliadau Rhyfel.**
Cafwyd adroddiad y Clerc nad oedd y Gofeb wedi ei lanhau oherwydd sefyllfa COVID ac oedd rhaid gohirio dathliadau Rhyfel a oedd wedi ei drefnu ar yr 8fed Mai 2020.
- 1892 Llwybrau/Footpaths – Rhifau 22 & 41 – Ardal Llansadwrn.**
Yn dilyn sylwadau Cyngorydd Tom Cooke, roedd y Clerc wedi ebostio y Cyngor Sir er mwyn dwyn sylw atynt fod angen gwelliannau i’r llwybrau. Cafwyd ymateb ganddynt ac roedd hyn wedi ei rhannu gyda’r Cadeirydd a Cyngorydd Tom Cooke ac roeddynt yn hapus gyda’r argymelliadau.
- 1893 Adroddiad Materion Priffyrdd yr Hen Bentref.**
Adroddiad byr gan y Clerc yn dilyn ebost dderbyniwyd ar y 4ydd Mai 2020 y bydd ffordd drwy Hen Llandegfan wedi cau dros dro, am dau ddiwrnod, er mwyn caniatau i BT wneud Gwaith ar gebl uwchben y Ffordd.

Yn dilyn cwynion roedd Cyngorydd Sirol Carwyn Jones wedi ei dderbyn am y coed oedd wedi ei dorri, roedd y sefyllfa wedi ei hadrodd i'r Cyngor Sir yn gofyn iddynt cynnal ymweliad a archwiliad i'r digwyddiad.

1873. WELCOME.

1873.1 The Chair welcomed everyone to the meeting, in particular, Mrs Rebecca Pritchard (Menter Môn) & Mr Seimon Hunt (Coed Cymru).

1873.2 He also thanked the clerk for his hard work during the period of the coronavirus and for providing a comprehensive agenda to the members of the Council.

1874. DECLARATION OF PERSONAL/PRELIMINARY INTEREST.

1874.1 Councillor Mr Eurfrlyn Davies declared a personal interest that was prejudicial to the Bryn Meurig planning application (item 39.4-LUE/2020/6) as a family connection was the former owner of the dwelling. He took no part in the discussions and the Council's comments.

1874.2 Councillors Mr John Griffiths & Alun Roberts declared a personal interest that was prejudicial in the Ynys y Big planning application (item 39.3 – FPL/2020/37) as both had been in discussion with the neighbour next door and responded with their own comments to the planning application. None of the two took any part in the discussions and the Council's comments.

1874.3 Councillor Mr John Wyn Griffiths declared a personal interest that was prejudicial to each planning application (item 39.1 and 39.9) as he was a member of the County Council's planning committee. He took no part in the discussions and the Council's comments.

- 1875** **CWLWM SEIRIOL REPORT - proposed zonal footpath – Llandegfan to the local Nature reserve (Cyttir).**
- 1875.1 The chair and Clerk thanked Mr Seimon Hunt for preparing the proposed document and all members had already received a copy in advance of the meeting. It was noted that walking the trails had been popular during the period of the coronavirus and following a concise discussion on the report containing Mr. Hunt's comments about the local naming and advertising of the trails, the clerk explained that he had been making enquiries and that the Council had an opportunity to prepare an official grant application through the National Community Fund – People & Places Scheme in order to make the improvements but the costs will have to be ascertained plus the precise content of Cwlwm Seiriol and the County Council willingness to contribute. **Members of the Council unanimously approved the idea and proposals and the Clerk would keep in touch with Mrs Rebecca Pritchard of Cwlwm Seiriol and Mr Arwel Evans, the County Council's Footpath officer and provide an update at the next meeting.**
- 1876 CADNANT PROJECT SCHEME.**
- 1876.1 The clerk gave a full report that he had been in contact with the Chair and the Vice Chair about landscape improvement ideas for Llandegfan, particular mention was made to the launch of the Local Place capital Grant scheme for Nature through the Heritage Lottery Fund and had sent a letter to the county Council seeking their views on the development of a piece of land along Lon Ganol and improving the site of the adjacent wall to Siop Llandeg to Bus Shelter opposite the Brynteg Estate. The clerk had circulated a copy of the document containing the ideas involved as well as the county Council's response. Clearly the scheme will have to be created, the landowners will need to grant permission and estimate accepted. The clerk said that time was short and that the Council's approval in principle was needed to move forward with the scheme and the subsidy application. **The members of the Council unanimously approved the idea and the proposal and the Clerk would report with an update at the next meeting (AR/JK).**
- 1877 Re Establishment the Pathways Sub-committee.**
- 1877.1 Following all the information discussed above, the clerk recommended that it was time for the Sub-Committee to be re-established to ensure the future of routes around the village of Llandegfan and Llansadwrn. **It was unanimously agreed and Councillors Nia Jones, Tom Cooke, Eurfrlyn Davies, Gareth Griffiths, John Griffiths and Idris Alan Jones were appointed on to the Committee and to extend an invitation to the members of the Cyttir Nature Reserve Advisory Group when meetings are convened.**

- 1878 The Clerk's report.**
- 1878.1 The Clerk reported briefly on the work undertaken during the coronavirus period and thanked the Chair and County Councillor Alun Roberts for their support and information that had been shared in order to ensure that the Council did not stall in its administration. The Chair thanked the Clerk for retaining and ensuring that the Council continued with its administration at such an uncertain time.
- 1879. COUNTY COUNCILLOR'S REPORT.**
- 1879.1 County Councillor, Alun Roberts, thanked Llinos Medi, leader of the County Council for her hard work and for attending joint meetings with the Welsh Government and fellow County Councils in North Wales to address all the day to day issues that were being raised during the peak coronavirus period. He was proud that Isle of Anglesey County Council was the only fully functioning local authority for recycling throughout the pandemic. He duly thanked all the School Teachers and Key Workers for all their hard work during these unprecedented times and to the Clerk of this Community Council for keeping all members updated with the coronavirus situation as it happened. The Chairman of the Community Council duly thanked Alun Roberts for his support and commitment shown to the local community. Finally, Council member John Wyn Griffith thanked all the voluntary community groups for assisting the vulnerable people in our community.

- 1881 Llansadwrn Flood Alleviation Scheme.**
1881.1 The clerk's reported that there was no change on the site. It was agreed that he would contact the property department to ask them about the latest position. In the meantime, and in the interests of health and safety, the playing field will have to remain closed.
- 1882 Tree Planting Llansadwrn Playground.**
1882.1 Following the agreement made in the March 2020 meeting and the current position outlined in minute 1881.1 above, any tree planting and the involvement of village children in the activity will have to be deferred until the situation is safe and allowed.

- 1883 REOPENING OF THE PLAYGROUNDS.**
The clerk said that the restrictions on the re-opening of playing fields had not been lifted by the Welsh Government and that he was waiting for the expected guidance and statement on Friday 10/7/2020 before the next steps are taken. In the meantime, he would be in contact with Ms Bethan Hywel Jones from the County Council and additional guidance from Zurich Insurance company in order to receive the position from the aspect of public liability.
- 1884 LON FAIN.**

With reference to comments made as per minute 1876, the clerk advised that the notice board could be located adjacent to the entrance of the Brynteg estate if the proposed scheme was successful.
- 1887 NEW BUS SHELTER SEATING.**
The clerk said that he had no development to the enquiries and therefore consideration had to be given to contacting other contractors for a price in order to report back to the next meeting.
- 1888 BT KIOSK – LLANSADWRN.**
The clerk said that the Kiosk was now the Community Council property and that we will need to move forward with the installation of a new defibrillator inside the kiosk in accordance with the agreement. Before moving on, the clerk reminded members that County Councillor Carwyn Jones had indicated that Alun Griffiths Contractors Limited will be willing to contribute a new defibrillator to the village as part of the flood alleviation scheme work but the situation must be confirmed and reported back to the next meeting.
- 1889 ADDITIONAL DEFIBRILLATOR INSTALLATIONS.**
Following queries and discussions with ' Welsh Hearts ', the clerk confirmed that he had good news and that the organisation had been successful in subsidising the installation of a new Defibrillator for the village. A suitable site for siting the machine was discussed and consideration was given to procuring and purchasing 4 others-total expenditure of around £ 5k. **Members agreed in principle and expected a further report at the next meeting.**

- 1890 Dog Dispenser & Bags Project.**
The clerk had been reading various comments on local social media platforms complaining about the dog fouling situation in the village and following the comments of the previous meeting, he had made inquiries about installing dog bag dispensers around the village. He said that it was the Community council and the AONB team who were responsible for choosing the location of the machine. The site will require an existing pole and should be close to the County Council's bin. Delivery of the machine will then be installed by the AONB team. Finally, he said that each of the dispenser costs £12.50 and that the county Council will initially provide bags from its remaining stock. Thereafter it will be for the Community council to pay to retain stock levels and fill the machine.
Members agreed to proceed with the project as a matter of urgency and to ask the clerk to make the relevant arrangements.
- 1891 Clean the Memorial & War celebrations.**
The clerk's reported that the memorial had not yet been cleaned due to the situation of COVID and that the scheduled war celebrations on the 8th May 2020 had to be postponed.
- 1892 Footpaths – Nos 22 & 41 – Llansadwrn area.**
Following observations made by Councillor Tom Cooke, the clerk had emailed the county council to highlight the need for improvements to the routes. Their response had been shared with the Chair and Councillor Tom Cooke and they were happy with the recommendations.
