**2666.1** Cais llawn i godi 30 o anheddau preswyl (100% o unedau tai fforddiadwy), newidiadau i'r fynedfa bresennol, creu mynedfa newydd a ffordd fynediad fewnol ynghyd â gwaith cysylltiedig ar: **Tir i'r Gogledd-Ddwyrain, Gwel y Llan, Llandegfan – FPL/2024/105** - cadarnhad gan y Clerc ei fod wedi casglu holl atebion y Cynghorwyr ac wedi cyflwyno sylwadau canlynol yn seiliedig ar astudio'r Datganiad Dylunio, Mynediad a Chynllunio a'r Gwerthusiad Ecolegol Ychwanegol.

### **TIRWEDD A CHYFFREDINOL:**

- Mae paragraff 2.4 yn crybwyll bod y tir dan sylw y tu allan i ffin anheddiad Llandegfan. Mae hyn yn cynrychioli ehangiad pellach o ddatblygiad trefol i dirwedd amaethyddol a ddefnyddiwyd ar un adeg ar gyfer pori gwartheg ychydig yn ôl. Para 5.29: Nid yw'r datblygiad hwn yn cynrychioli "talgrynnu" ffin yr anheddiad. Mae'n estyniad pellach i safle maes glas.
- Para 3.10 Mae'r gwrych a'r coed ar hyd y llwybr mynediad i Cyttr Bach yn nodwedd tirwedd a chynefin bwysig o'r cae presennol. Nodir yn y Gwerthusiad Ecolegol (para 3.17) y gallai'r "Lôn Werdd a'r gwrych fod o arwyddocâd hanesyddol i'r ffin"
- Para 3.1: Mae'r angen i adeiladu'r pant dŵr wyneb a'r basn cysylltiedig yn cynrychioli effaith bellach eto ar y datblygiad hwn ar cefn gwlad agored y tu allan i ffin anheddiad y pentref ac mae'n bosibl y gellid ei ddefnyddio i gyfiawnhau ehangu datblygiad pellach. Nodwyd bod "Mynediad Amaethyddol" ar ddiwedd y ffordd sbardun arfaethedig i'r Gogledd o'r safle ger y man agored arfaethedig yn edrych fel estyniad ffordd yn y dyfodol, fel yr un yng Ngwel y Llan ar hyn o bryd.
- Mae'n werth nodi hefyd fod coed ar y ffin gyda Gwel Eryri eisoes wedi eu torri yn ddiangen a heb ymgynghori gyda'r tai cyfagos gan nodi mai Coed ynn yw'r rheswm - mae hyn yn ffeithiol anghywir ac yn gwbl anghyfrifol ar rhan safle'r. ymgeisydd.

- Mae gan y pant a'i fasn cysylltiedig y potensial i gael eu datblygu fel nodwedd ecolegol werthfawr yn hytrach nag fel ateb peirianyddol di-flewyn ar dafod. Gresynir y diffyg uchelgais.
- Para 3.13 Mae'r gwerthusiad ecolegol yn cofnodi y bydd y datblygiad hwn yn cael effaith gymedrol ar ystlumod (para 4.3), fodd bynnag nid oes unrhyw fanylion yn y datganiad cyffredinol bod “hibernacula gaeafgysgu”.
- Mae paragraff 5.64 yn cydnabod bod gan y goeden onnen hynafol ar ffin y lôn werdd sy'n arwain at Cyttir Bach werth clwydo ystlumod. O arsylwadau personol gan ganfodyddion ystlumod, cofnodwyd cryn weithgaredd ystlumod ar hyd y lôn hon gyda'r cyfnos.
- Bydd mwy o oleuadau stryd oherwydd y datblygiad hwn yn cael effaith andwyol ar symudiad ystlumod yng nghyffiniau'r lôn werdd a phrofiad o “awyr dywyll” .
- Para 5.66: Pe byddai'r datblygiad yn cael ei ganiatáu, mae'n hanfodol bod manylion unrhyw welliannau i fioamrywiaeth yn cael eu cytuno ymlaen llaw, eu hariannu'n ddigonol, eu sicrhau trwy gytundeb Adran 106, a'u goruchwyllo gan ecolegydd proffesiynol cymwys.
- Para Mae 5.3.3 o'r Gwerthusiad Ecolegol yn awgrymu gwahanol rywogaethau o goed i'w defnyddio wrth dirlunio. Dylid defnyddio rhywogaethau coed brodorol yn hytrach na stoc garddwriaethol anffrodorol.

- Para 2.5: Byddai'r datblygiad yn effeithio ar y rhan ddi-drefol gyntaf o rwydwaith llwybrau troed Cylch Cyttir Llandegfan, gan gynyddu'r rhan o'r palmant ymhellach. Mae'n rhaid i'r HTC hwn fod yn gwbl hygyrch bob amser, pe bai'r datblygiad hwn yn mynd yn ei flaen.

## **MYNEDIAD FFORDD**

- Mae paragraff 2.3 yn nodi “Mae perchennog tir safle'r cais yn elwa o hawl mynediad i safle'r cais o Gwel Eryri.” Nid oes mynediad giât yn y fan hon sy'n ffordd bengaead ar hyn o bryd ac a derfynir gan 3 bonyn coed hynafol a dorrwyd yn yr hydref y llynedd. Nododd yr arolwg ecolegol fod un o'r coed yn “hen goed gyda bollt mwy na 2m mewn diamedr.”
- Para 7.3: Bydd symud traffig adeiladu trwy Gwel Eryri/Carreg Felin a Gwel y Llan yn achosi anghyfleustra ac aflonyddwch difrifol, yn enwedig os yw ceir wedi parcio ar y ffordd. Ni fyddai cyfyngiad parcio ceir ar y ffordd yn dderbyniol. Mae teithio lorïau trwy Gwel Eryri yn anymarferol ac yn beryglus oherwydd sawl cornel ddall. Mae hyn yn rhan o'r prif bryder i drigolion Llandegfan. Mae'r llwybr o waelod Allt Cichle eisoes yn peri ei broblemau ei hun ac mae'r llwybr lôn gefn amgen o gyffordd Pentraeth Automotive yn rhy gul i gerbydau mawr. Nid yw'r rhwydwaith ffyrdd o amgylch Llandegfan i gyd wedi ei gynllunio i ddarparu ar gyfer y cerbydau mawr a welwn heddiw ac nid yw Cyffordd Maldwyn ger Siop Llandegfan yn ddigon llydan i lorïau sydd angen hyd y gyffordd gyfan i droi i fyny tuag at yr Ysgol Gynradd a thu hwnt a gall ond rhagweld anhrefn llwyr. Mae'r ffordd hon eisoes yn brif lwybr Bws a rhaid cofio pan adeiladwyd Gwel y Llan am y tro cyntaf, nid oedd rampiau cyflymder ar y brif ffordd na thrwy Mill Lodge/Stâd Gwel Eryri.

## **CASGLIAD:**

- Gwrthwynebu'r datblygiad yma fel estyniad trefol annerbyniol i gefn gwlad agored gerllaw anheddiad presennol.
- Nid yw'n cynrychioli datblygiad “talgrynnu” na “mewnlenwi”.
- Dylid lleoli rhagor o dai fforddiadwy yn y gymuned mewn lleoliadau llai ymwthiol. Mae'r lleoliad arfaethedig hwn yn gwbl anaddas ar gyfer datblygiad o'r fath.
- Mae'r isadeiledd draenio ychwanegol yn cynyddu ôl troed y datblygiad hwn.

- 2556 Welcome.**  
The Chairman welcomed all Councillors to the meeting.

## 2666 ***New Planning Applications.***

2666.1 Full application for the erection of 30 residential dwellings (100% affordable housing units), alterations to existing access, creation of new access and internal access road together with associated works on: **Land to the North-East of Gwel y Llan, Llandegfan – FPL/2024/105** – confirmation from the Clerk that he had collated all the responses in order to submit the following observation(s) and these comments are based on studying the Design, Access & Planning Statement and Additional Ecological Appraisal

### **LANDSCAPE & GENERAL:**

- Para 2.4 mentions the land in question lies outside the settlement boundary of Llandegfan. This represents a further expansion of urban development into an agricultural landscape that was once used for cattle grazing not long ago. Para 5.29: This development does not represent a “rounding off” of the settlement boundary. It is a further expansion onto a green field site.
- Para 3.10 The hedgerow and trees along the access track to Cyttir Bach are an important landscape & habitat feature of the existing field. It is noted in the Ecological Appraisal (para 3.17) that the “Green Lane and hedgerow may have historic boundary significance”
- Para 3.1: The need for construction of the surface water swale and associated basin represents yet a further impact of this development on the open countryside out with the settlement boundary of the village and could possibly be used to justify further expansion of development. Noted that “Agricultural Access” at the end of the proposed spur road to North of site near the proposed open space has an appearance of a future road extension, like that currently at Gwel y Llan.
- It is also worth noting that Trees on the boundary with Gwel Eryri have already been cut unnecessarily and without consultation with the neighbouring dwellings citing that Ash Die-back being the reason – this is factually incorrect and totally irresponsible on the part of the applicant.
- Para 5.23 of the Design, Access & Planning Statement is incorrect – the Cae Ffynnon development is for 3 units not 1 as stated.
- There is a complete absence of comments regarding the re-routing of the power line which crosses the site. This needs to be considered further due to landscape and potential habitat disturbance.

## **BIODIVERSITY**

- The swale and its associated basin has the potential to be developed as a valuable ecological feature rather than as a bland engineering solution. The lack of ambition is regretted.
- Para 3.13 The ecological appraisal records that this development will have a moderate impact on bats (para 4.3) , however the general statement that “bat hibernacula” lacks any detail.
- Para 5.64 recognises that the veteran ash tree on the boundary of the green lane leading to Cyttir Bach has bat roosting value. From personal bat detector observations, considerable bat activity along this lane at dusk has been recorded.
- Increased street lighting because of this development will have an adverse impact on bat movement in the vicinity of the green lane and experience of “dark sky”.
- Para 5.66: Should the development be permitted it is crucial that details of any biodiversity enhancement was agreed in advance, adequately funded, secured through a Section 106 agreement, and overseen by a professionally competent ecologist.
- Para 5.3.3 of the Ecological Appraisal suggests various tree species to be used in landscaping. Native tree species should be used in preference to horticultural non-native stock.

## **PROW ACCESS**

- Para 2.5: The development would impact on the first non-urbanised section of the Cylch Cyttir Llandegfan footpath network, increasing the pavement section further. This PROW must always be fully accessible, if this development was to proceed.

## **ROAD ACCESS**

- Para 2.3 states that “The landowner of the application site benefits from right of access to the application site from Gwel Eryri.” There is no gate access at this point which is currently a cul-de-sac and is ended by 3 tree stumps of veteran trees which were felled last Autumn. The ecological survey noted that one of the trees was “a veteran with bole more than 2 m diameter”.

- Para 7.3: Movement of construction traffic through Gwel Eryri/Carreg Felin and Gwel y Llan will cause severe inconvenience and disruption, especially if cars are parked on the road. Car parking restriction on the road would not be acceptable. Passage of lorries via Gwel Eryri is impracticable and dangerous due to several blind corners. This forms part of the main concern to the residents of Llandegfan. The route from the bottom of Allt Cichle already poses its own problems and the alternative back lane route from the Pentraeth Automotive junction is too narrow for large vehicles. The road network around the whole of Llandegfan has not been designed to cater for the large vehicles we see today and the Maldwyn Junction by Siop Llandegfan is not sufficiently wide enough for lorries who will need the whole length of the junction to turn up towards the Primary School and beyond and we can only envisage total chaos. This road is already the main Bus route and one has to bear in mind that when Gwel y Llan was first built, there were no speed ramps on either the main road or through the Mill Lodge/Gwel Eryri estate.

#### **CONCLUSION:**

- This development should be opposed as an unacceptable urban extension into open countryside adjacent to an existing settlement.
- It does not represent a “rounding off” or “infilling” development.
- Provision of further affordable housing within the community should be sited in less visually obtrusive locations. This proposed location is totally unsuitable for such development.
- The additional drainage infrastructure increases the footprint of this development.
- There is real concern regarding the use of existing roads to permit access to this site. There isn’t currently any access to the site via Gwel Eryri. The premature felling of mature trees last Autumn was very regrettable.
- The Cylch Cyttir Llandegfan path will be impacted by this development and further urbanised.
- If the development was permitted, adequate planning and maintenance of realistic biodiversity and landscape enhancement will be necessary, secured through Section 106 agreements and funding.

It is for the above reasons that members of this Community Council are opposed to the proposed development and that it is currently outside the parameters of the Gwynedd & Anglesey Joint Local Development Plan.
